The Town reserves the right to cancel at least 30 days in advance of the event.

Rental fees are non-refundable unless cancelled prior to 10 days before the event date.

The playground/walking trail/bathrooms are ALWAYS open to the public. No renter shall deny entry to or use of the playground, bathrooms and walking trail to others wishing to use it.

___ In the event of damage to the town's property while the event is taking place, or due to negligence of the renter to follow all rules, the renter shall assume all responsibilities for the cost of repairs.

RENTAL RULES

1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND.**

5. Turn off all lights, heat/air, running water before you leave and lock the front door only.
6. Take down all streamers, decorations, balloons, etc. Before you leave.
7. Do not leave food in the fridge or on the counters. Take it with you.
8. Please place all tables/chairs/blinds back the way you found them.
9. No motorized vehicles allowed inside the park or on the walking trail. (other than motorized wheelchairs)
